# **Health Office Information**

**Medication pickup-** All medication must be picked up by a parent/guardian by 12:00 PM on Wednesday May 26th, 2021. This is the last day of school and it is a half day for students. You can pick up medications anytime at your convenience before the last day.

**Medication Disposal-** Our school nurse will follow state guidelines and dispose of all medications not picked up by 1:00 PM on the last day of school. Medications cannot be kept in the health office over the summer. Thank you for your understanding.

**Medication for 2021- 2022-** If medications are needed for 2021-2022 school year, you may obtain new forms from the PSD website. You can click here: Authorization and **Release For Administering Medicine to Student at School or School- Sponsored Activity** You may also visit PSD visit **www.psdschools.org**, click on Parents, click on Student Health (scroll down on right side). Scroll down to #6 of the Health Services/Guidelines. Please fill out the appropriate Health Care Action Plan form along with the Authorization to Administer Medication Form. All forms must be signed by the students health care provider, legal guardian, and contain clear dosage and administration instructions. Medication forms MUST be filled out every year!

#### Vaccine exemptions for 2021-2022

There are new guidelines from the state regarding vaccine exemptions. Starting with the 2021-2022 school year, you must now have a health care provider sign the exemption form.
