Here are the projects each grade level is currently working on in art:

Kindergarten: Using shapes, line and color to create VanGogh Styled *Sunflowers*.

First Grade: Investigating color line and pattern to create a Romero Britto inspired *Hug* picture.

Second Grade: Making dancing giraffes inspired by the book *Giraffes Can't Dance* (Andreae & Parker-Rees)

Third Grade: Investigating Ancient Egypt and creating *Royal Portraits* in this style.

Fourth Grade: Using warm and cool colors to create a silhouette painting of a favorite animal.

Fifth Grade: Using a variety of techniques to create *Aspen Trees* similar to the ones they saw at Eco-Week.
